Objective

The Field Service Representative collects casual data and observational information from product in various retail stores, including mass merchandise stores.

Essential Functions:

- Must meet and greet store management with a professional and positive attitude
- Be appropriately dressed, and available to answer questions and develop store-level relationships with store personnel
- Displaying new releases, promotional material, replenishment of product, conduct audits, place Point of Purchase (POP) materials.
- Ensure that the product is in accordance with the Plan-o-gram.
- If employee meets requirements, they may be eligible for a PDA request.

Qualifications / Requirements:

- Have retail and/or merchandising experience
- Must have valid/active e-mail address with ability to report completions via the web
- Must be able to work flexible hours, nights and weekends
- Must be able to stand, bend, climb, stoop, kneel, stretch and lift up to 40 pounds
- Report work completions on the day of service
- Complete work with assigned service window
- Must be able to read Plan-o-grams
- Reliable transportation
- Proof of Auto Insurance
- Valid drivers license
- Check e-mail daily
- Fax & Printer
